1. Call Meeting to Order

Mayor Sjoblad called the meeting of the Pequot Lakes City Council to order at 5:15 p.m.

2. Consider Agenda

3. Board of Canvass

Nancy Malecha informed the Council of the following statistics from the November 8, 2016 General Election.

- Number of new registrants on Election Day – 202
- Total number of votes cast at the Election – 1,187
- Percentage of voters to total registered voters – 81%

Ms. Malecha outlined the following vote results for the offices of Mayor and Council Member for the City of Pequot Lakes.

Mayor

- Nancy A. Adams – 861
- Write-In – 70
- Over Votes - 0
- Under Votes – 256
- Total – 1,187

Council Member

- Mimi Swanson – 422

- Maury Graham – 217
- Jason Baca – 370
- Scott Pederson – 610
- Write-In – 25
- Over Votes – 4
- Under Votes – 726
- Total – 2,374

Ms. Malecha further noted that per the vote results the Mayor-elect will be Nancy A. Adams and Council Members-elect will be Scott Pederson and Mimi Swanson with their terms of office beginning in January of 2017.

COUNCIL MEMBER AKERSON MOVED TO ADOPT RESOLUTION 16-27 CANVASSING THE NOVEMBER 8, 2016 MUNICIPAL GENERAL ELECTION RESULTS. COUNCIL MEMBER KARR SECONDED THE MOTION. MOTION CARRIED 5-0.
