Pequot Lakes Police Monthly Report

September 2019: During the month of September (1st-30st), the Pequot Lakes Police Department has a record of 248 calls for service. Call types include but are not limited to:

Notable Calls:

On 9/14/19, Sgt. Chad Turcotte was on routine patrol when he witnessed a vehicle travelling south on Patriot Ave, who's driver was showing a revoked status. Sgt. Turcotte conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle in the Supervalu parking lot. During a search of the vehicle, officers located 56 grams of methamphetamine, several items of drug paraphernalia and over \$500 in cash. All three occupants of the vehicle were placed under arrest. The cash and vehicle are pending forfeiture. Sgt. Turcotte was assisted by the Nisswa and Breezy Point Police Departments.

On 9/18/19, dispatch received a report of a welfare check on a male slumped over in a vehicle. Officer Ryan Franz was the first on scene and discovered that the male was deceased. The male was later identified as Kurt Joseph Streiff. The Pequot Lakes Police Department published a press release on the matter asking for the public's help. This case continues to be under active investigation.
