Pequot Lakes Police Monthly Report

January 2019: During the month of January (1st-31st), the Pequot Lakes Police Department has a record of 208 calls for service. Call types include but are not limited to:

Notable Calls:

On 1/4/19, Officer Matt Jorgens was on routine patrol in Jenkins when he conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle for failing to maintain a single lane, tail light out and a cracked windshield. Upon making contact with the driver, Officer Jorgens suspected he was under the influence of alcohol. Officer Jorgens performed field sobriety testing on the driver and also conducted a search of the vehicle. The driver was ultimately arrested for 4th Degree DWI and carrying a pistol while under the influence.

During the month of January, our area accumulated approximately 18 inches of snow. Officers responded to numerous weather related calls this month including crashes, motorist assists and vehicles off the road.
