# *Pequot Lakes Police Monthly Report*

**November 2018:** During the month of November (1<sup>st</sup>-30<sup>th</sup>), the Pequot Lakes Police Department has a record of 244 calls for service. Call types include but are not limited to:

**Notable Calls:**

On 11/7/18, Chief Eric Klang performed a routine traffic stop on a vehicle in Jenkins. When Chief Klang suspected a DWI, Officer Franz came to the scene to assist. Officer Franz performed field sobriety testing and a PBT. The male driver was ultimately arrested for gross misdemeanor 3<sup>rd</sup> degree DWI.

On 11/7/18, Officer Matt Jorgens was on patrol when he observed a truck in the area of an attempted break-in earlier in the day being driven by a male who had a history of thefts. Officer Jorgens developed probable cause to stop the vehicle. A Nisswa officer came to assist. The male was ultimately arrested for felony drug possession and felony receiving stolen property.
