# *Pequot Lakes Police Monthly Report*

---

**March 2019:** During the month of April (1<sup>st</sup>-30<sup>st</sup>), the Pequot Lakes Police Department has a record of 310 calls for service. Call types include but are not limited to:

- Alarm
- Civil Problem
- Disturbance
- Driving Complaint
- Found Property
- Intoxicated Person
- Noise Complaint
- Suspicious Activity
- Theft
- Threats
- Welfare Check

**Notable Calls:**

On 4/3/19, Officer Sheri Fyle was dispatched to A-Pine gas station to assist a Cass County deputy with an intoxicated male. The male had been walking down Hwy 371, attempting to get his friend's apartment in Pequot Lakes. The male told Officer Fyle he didn't know the address but could give directions. Due to the cold weather and his intoxication, Officer Fyle began a courtesy transport for the male to his friend's apartment. The male got agitated trying to give Officer Fyle directions and began yelling. Officer Fyle made the decision to transport to detox. The male became combative, hitting the cage of the squad car. He was also combative with jail staff. The male was arrested for disorderly conduct.

On 4/11/19, Officer Matt Jorgens was on routine patrol when he observed a vehicle change lanes without signaling. Officer Jorgens stopped the vehicle, which was occupied by three people. Officer Jorgens observed quickly that all passengers were showing signs of recent drug use. The driver also admitted to not having a valid driver's license. A Nisswa and Breezy Point officer came to the scene to assist, as well as a Crow Wing County deputy. A search of the vehicle resulted in finding approximately 50 grams of meth. All parties arrested for various charges. Vehicle is pending forfeiture.
