**Subject:** COVID-19 Pandemic Relief Considerations – Liquor License Fees

**Report:** In an effort to provide the City Council with relief considerations for our community during the COVID-19 pandemic, I am suggesting the Council consider providing a four month reduction in the renewal liquor license fees to establishments for the remaining current license period which expires on June 30<sup>th</sup>. The Governor's Executive Order required all bars and restaurants to close to customers on March 17<sup>th</sup>. This reduction would be for establishments who currently hold an On Sale/Sunday license and an On Sale 3.2% Malt Liquor/Wine/Strong Beer license.

The following is a breakdown of establishments and potential reduction amounts.

- American Legion Club - \$667 reduction
- Latte' Da Coffee & Gifts - \$75 reduction
- Lucky's Tavern - \$667 reduction
- Pequot Bar & Grill - \$667 reduction
- Preserve Golf Club - \$667 reduction
- Tasty Pizza North – \$75 reduction
- Timberjack Smokehouse & Saloon - \$667 reduction
- TOTAL = \$3,485 reduction in fees

**Council Action Requested:** Council motion approving a four month reduction in the renewal liquor license fees for On Sale/Sunday license holders and On Sale 3.2% Malt Liquor/Wine/Strong Beer license holders as presented for a total reduction in fees of \$3,485 due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
