**Public Works Activities for the month of August**

1. Cleaning Buildings, Watering Plants, and emptying trash cans around town.
2. Weekly mowing of parks, cemetery, and city hall.
3. Mowing ditches as time permits.
4. Limbing trees in parks and along road right of way
5. Gathering bids for random street repairs.
  - We have two places that are sinking/need overlay, Pillsbury (\$5210)/ Cullen Cove (\$10630).
  - I have gathered a bid from CAR INC. The bid is for 3 Days of Spray Patching on 4 roads Wilderness, Hurtig, Krist CT and EastWood Dr. I am asking for \$12495 from carryover funds to pay for this project. They also will repair our manholes that tend to snag plow edges.
  - Delay in response from crack sealing company we contracted in May, so I discussed with CAR INC. about crack sealing, and they believe they can fit us in this season.
  - We have a budget this year of \$10,000 in crack sealing repairs and we have about \$70,000 worth of crack sealing projects currently that is on hold.
  - Chip Sealing Patriot Ave is on our minds for next year. Chip Sealing would add a new surface and cover the old lines. The county would like to know the roads we want chip seal by November so they can acquire bids. Patriot Ave. is 2.6 Miles long. The formula for pricing is: one mile of 20' Road is 11,733 square yards x \$2.50 per sq. yd. = \$29,333 plus the county charges 5%. Patriot Avenue has portions that are 40' wide, so est \$60,000
6. New Park walkway lighting is up and operational.
7. Gutters were repaired on City Hall.
8. Windows were sealed in the Fire Hall TV room.
9. Teamed up with Ideal public works to do some Hot Patching Ackerson/Nelson/Wild Acres.
10. Awaiting bid on Coleman Drive concept.
11. We are ready to place 2 JD Mowers up for sale.
