Subject: Safe Streets for All Planning Grant

Report: USDOT has established a program prioritizing traffic safety including vulnerable users referred to as Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) The City of Crosslake has agreed to lead a SS4A planning effort.

The City of Pequot Lakes is being asked to be a co-applicant. Everyone is anticipating no financial commitment is needed from the City/Cities/Townships. As stated in the resolution the intent is to have State match money take care of the non-federal local match share.

RESOLUTION TO BE CO-APPLICANT FOR THE SS4A PLANNING GRANT

WHEREAS, the City of Pequot Lakes is responsible to provide for streets and other transportation facilities such as trails and sidewalks to connect people, goods, and services in a safe and equitable manner; and

WHEREAS, the USDOT has established a program prioritizing traffic safety including vulnerable users referred to as Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A); and

WHEREAS, the SS4A program allows for Co-Applicants; and

WHEREAS, the City of Crosslake has agreed to lead a SS4A planning effort if funded by the USDOT including townships and towns in the resort area of northern Crow Wing County, MN and eastern Cass County, MN;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Pequot Lakes agrees to be a Co-Applicant to the City of Crosslake's application for a SS4A planning grant through the USDOT to develop a Safety Action Plan with a particular focus on vulnerable users. The City of Pequot Lakes also agrees to be an active participant in the development of the plan and to financially commit the non-federal share if State match money is not available for the non-federal share.
