Interfaith Volunteers

Currently serving those in Pequot Lakes and Crow Wing County that are 60 years of age and older, including those with disabilities that live independently. They do not have handicap accessible vehicles.

There is no charge for their services; however, they do accept and appreciate donations to help with the cost of services received. All drivers are volunteers (not paid), using their own vehicles with insurance and have all been background checked. Please know those requesting rides/services could be asked to have a background check completed, this is for the safety of all involved.

Transportation services are for medical appointments, grocery shopping, and general errands. They're available Monday through Friday during 'normal business hours'. They'll provide pick up and drop off at the homes of individuals. They'd like at least a 3-day' notice so they can schedule appropriately. Scheduling can be done via their website, email or directly by phone.
